## Settling In.....

Settling In....that's the key word. I used to wonder why it took so long for a missionary to get going – now I know. Everything takes longer. Lots of red tape, different rules, different culture and you are doing everything to simply live, all at one time. Cooking is different and the shopping is very different. From setting up house all the way to immigration issues, but we are in our home and things are going great. Life has been so busy lately – from sun up to sun down.

We could never have orchestrated what God did in our own strength (Pictures below). Not only did God provide a house, but we also have a new addition to our family - a 17 year old Taiwanese girl. She is a blessing. We truly see the hand of God involved in all this. Her name is Winnie and she will live with us for at least one more year.

We have started meeting as a church in our home. We have had the privilege of seeing one young lady rededicate her life back to the Lord. We have four families committing to us. Last week we had 17 total in attendance. We are beginning to rent a small room near the University this Sunday. By this summer, I hope to have 20 adults meeting with us. Our plans are quiet simple. Crowds look great for photo ops and the "WOW" factor, but true sustainable development of leaders is best done in a mentoring (discipling)

relationship – like Jesus did it. We choose not to “WOW” our ministry partners with huge numbers, we desire to leave something in Belize that is sustainable, reproducible and, most importantly, eternal. If we follow the Lord and do it right, reproducible leaders will produce exponentially more reproducible leaders who will touch all of Belize and beyond. Jesus focused on the twelve and they, empowered by the Holy Spirit, turned the world upside down. So if we remain faithful to our purpose and pour into this small band of 20 adults – this small band of Belizeans will become strong, mature, and touch far beyond our reach. So we choose to forgo the “WOW” and focus on a truly Biblical model of raising up powerful leaders in Belize. The team that the Lord has already brought to us is amazing. God is so good.

The Lord is continuing to place people in our path that we are praying for. There is a young lady who sells some type of fruit drink on the street of a main road. The Lord has placed her on my wife’s heart. There is a young man who works where we had to fill out some immigration forms. When we spoke to him about our church, his first words were, “I am too far gone”. I think God must have smiled when he said this. God specializes in the too far gone people around us. God gave me a word when I was in the US, that He was looking for some Sauls in Belize and would turn them into Pauls. Pray for us as we meet the Sauls and see God transform them into Pauls.

We have two teams coming this summer and one in November. Please pray for the teams as they come. It’s going to be a busy and productive time of ministry this summer.

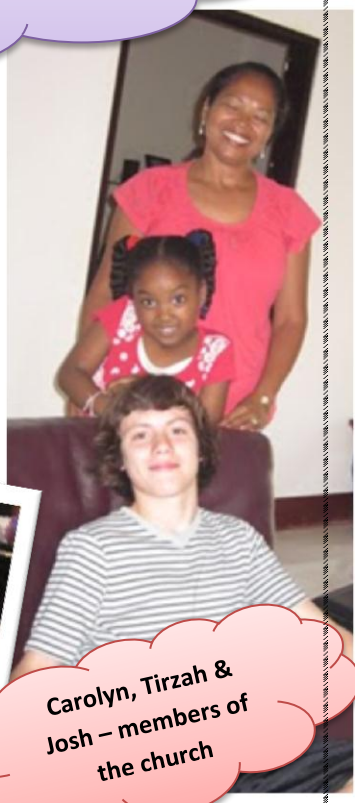
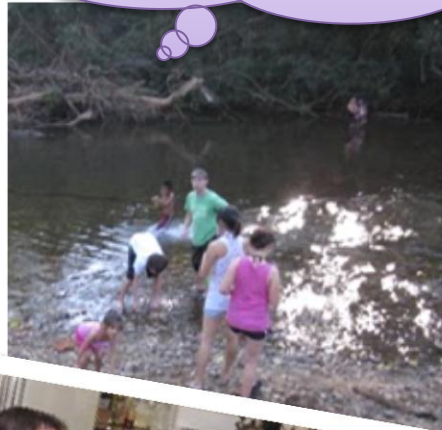

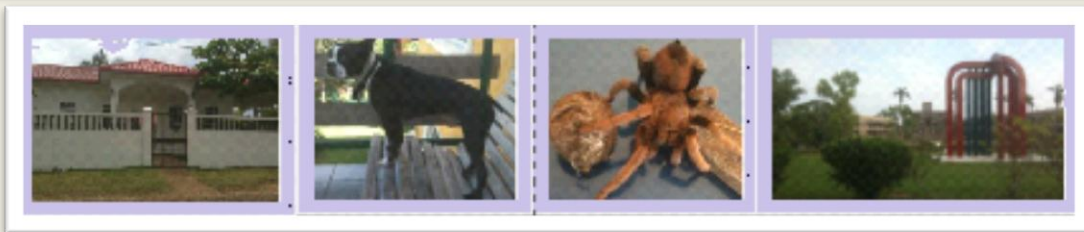
