Wow, June was such an effective and busy month of ministry. There is so much to tell you about. Two ministry teams, powerful ministry, salvations, baptisms and so much more.

When the Ministry Team from Katy, TX. was here, we went to the circus to minister to the kids of the circus. The children who travel with the circus, live a very hard life, so we went to share Jesus with them and to just love on them. Pictured is the team acting out Daniel and the Lion's Den in front of the tiger cage and the other picture is Johanna and me with a baby tiger. They were so excited to show us the tiger. We were as blessed as they were.



Both Ministry Teams went to a village called Maya Mopan. 99% of them are Mayans living in the suburbs of Belmopan. Many homes do not have running water, electricity (or they just have an extension cord from another home), thatched roofs, showers are outside, all have outhouses and most are dirt floors. They live very hard lives and many have medical problems that go untreated. So we prayed for many and they testified to their healing. We plan on building a relationship with them so that when the time is right, we will plant a church back there for them. I met a young lady named Cristina (22), married with two kids that translated for us. I felt that the Lord wants to use her to touch this community.



The church is going awesome. The members are growing so much in the Lord. There are new people every week. They are coming by word of mouth only. They are coming because they hear that we are discipling our people. When I share with people I meet in the community, many have already heard about LifeNet. God is strategically linking us with specific people. We have many ethnicities attending, two of our members work at the local television station, most are younger than 25. They are coming hungry for spiritual fathers and mothers. Through the ministry teams, Celebration or our Net Group – we have seen over **17** come to the Lord in June and have baptized **4** in the river. We are loving watching God raise up reproducible disciples.
