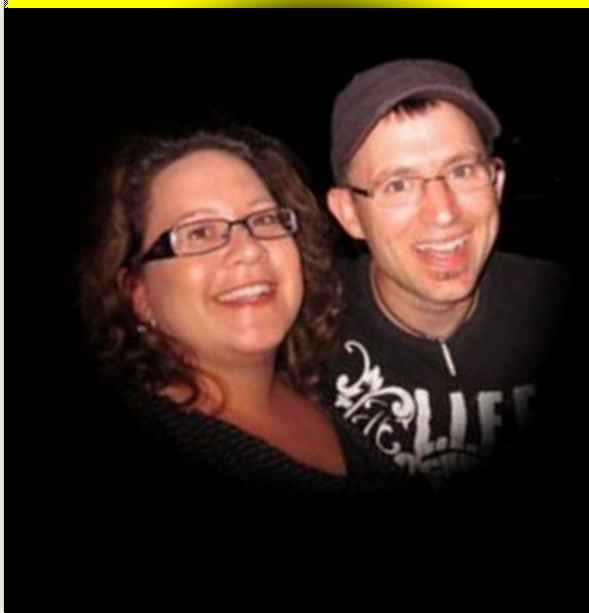

## *Why are we calling our church plant: LifeNet?*

The first time I came to minister in Belize over 10 years ago, God gave me the name *LifeNet*. **LIFE** stands for : L – Leading Others To Jesus; I – Instilling A Love For God; F – Fellowship As Family; and E – Every Member A Minister. **NET**, when Jesus called the disciples to be fishers-of-men, they were used to fishing with a net. We are not called to reach out to the world around us alone, we are called to reach out as a team. If you will, a net. Our cell groups will be called NET Groups. We will reach out to Belmopan and beyond as a net and see people saved, discipled and raised up as reproducible leaders.

This picture of a double rainbow was captured from my house overlooking Belmopan. It reminds me of Deuteronomy 11:14, *Then I will give you the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the latter rain, that you may gather in your grain, your new wine, and your oil.* God is getting ready to rain on Belize, not just any rain – He is about to pour out His presence, His power, and His purpose on the people of Belize. Not just through *LifeNet*, but through the life giving churches here. God is raising up young leaders to impact this beautiful nation. Let it rain Lord, let it rain.

*Then I will give you the rain for your land in its season, the early rain and the latter rain, that you may gather in your grain, your new wine, and your oil. Deuteronomy 11:14 (NKJV)*

We started meeting with just our family in our hotel, then our apartment and then our home. Now we have started meeting on Sundays at The George Price Center in two rooms, one for our children and the other for us to celebrate the Lord in. We have live worship from Dale Hulse with his guitar. We have about 20-25 people attending. Not a bad start for six weeks. We have had 6 salvations in the month of April. Many people have prayed the prayer of salvation here in Belize, but have no understanding of why and what that means. Discipleship is so important here.

Our first Easter in Belize. Wow, what a day! Such a great time of ministry. We turned the cross as a symbol of pain and torture into a symbol of resurrection and salvation. It was beautiful. Even more important than that, we felt the Easter Sunday was a turning point for us. We are seeing these young adults come to a real faith in Christ. They are connecting with us and we are able to speak boldly into their lives. They are hungry for all of God, but have never had someone to walk with them through the process of growing in the Lord. We are about to start meeting on Thursday nights with some of the young people to begin discipling them. God is turning Sauls into Pauls.... These young people are going to influence their network of relationships to passionately serve the Lord with their whole hearts.

Belize is a melting pot of cultures. Just look at our infant church. We have Taiwanese, Creole, Mestizo, Indian, Nigerian and of course our Texas faces. Yes, I consider Texas its own culture. (Not really, well – sort of!!)

We can't wait to see what next year's Easter will look like. We will have even more new Believers and the new ones from this year will be becoming powerful, reproducible godly leaders. We will sing the song...*Look what the Lord has done...*

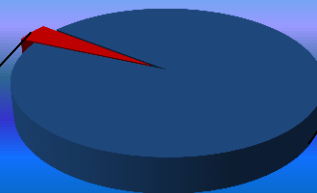

This graph reflects what percentage of our funding that was actually received from the previous month. For example: If our monthly needs are \$ 1000 and we received only \$ 800 in the previous month – then the graph would reflect that 80% of our monthly needs were received, while we fell 20% shy of our monthly budgetary needs.

Praise God, last month we received 100% of our needed funding for the ministry. God is so good to us. There is always more vision than funding though. We also realize that sometimes funding slacks off and we pray that the Lord will raise up new churches and Believers to support the great things that God is doing here. We are confident He will.
