Exciting Times

Every month, I have so much to say, there are just so many really cool things that God is doing here in Belmopan. *Exciting times.....*

1. Let me start by celebrating what the Lord has done over the last 8 Months: **29 salvations, 9 baptisms (5 more soon), 14 in leadership development** to become healthy reproducible leaders. Not simply passive discipleship, but a strategic focused method within a relational small group.
2. Our **Thursday Night College Net Group** had **26 young people** in our house last week. It continues to grow. Young leaders hungry for Spiritual Fathers to pour into them and raise them up into great leaders. Saw two pray to accept Jesus in October and two more sought a deeper level of discipleship as they minister in the schools. So we are developing them as they pour into others. That's the plan and it's unfolding...
3. Our Sunday celebration has seen its **largest** attendance this last month. Every week we have visitors. We will move to a larger room on November 20th.
4. Planning some cool outreach events in November and December – please be praying for us.
5. Planning 6 more baptisms soon. *Exciting Times.....*



Budget Update:

We still need to raise our monthly support. The onetime gifts are still making up the difference, but please agree with us that our monthly support will increase. A praise report is that one new church has chosen to begin supporting us and another church should decide soon. Please pray that 3-4 more churches will partner with us financially.

I send this newsletter to over 500 individuals and churches. Some partner with us financially and others partner with us by interceding for us. Both forms of partnership are needed. I would ask the roughly 400 families that are reading this newsletter to pray about monthly sowing financially into this ministry. The support does not have to be huge. We have some supporters who support us \$20.00 a month. All of this adds up to make up our budget. The last page of this newsletter shares two ways to give. I thank all of our partners for being there for us. Your prayers and financial support is so vital to carrying on the ministry here in Belize. Thank you!!
